(d) Synergistic Activities (Selected)

1. In 2005, directed the initiative to translate, analyze and make available for counterterrorism researchers the *Encyclopedia of Jihad*, a three-thousand page compilation of tactics, techniques and procedures developed by al-Qa`ida.
2. In 2006, directed a multi-million dollar Department of Defense sponsored project to systematically analyze the Salafist-Jihadist movement. The project was called a “paradigm shift” by senior military leadership.
3. Served as a grant and manuscript reviewer for the Smith-Richardson Foundation, the *Terrorism and Political Violence* journal, Potomac Press, Routledge Press and the Department of Defense.
4. Since 2007, helped to oversee the Combating Terrorism Center’s ‘Harmony Project,’ a DoD sponsored effort to make previously classified docs from the GWOT available to academic researchers.
5. In 2008, worked closely with the Department of Defense to build, analyzed and released the largest public database on GTMO detainees drawing on previously unreleased data from the Office of the Secretary of Defense.
